

Town Electors:

Many of you may have already seen the official publication for the request for absentee ballots in the Lake Mills Leader. Just a reminder to get your requests for absentee in as soon as possible. They must be written requests so please use the form linked [here](#). Complete the form, and mail it or drop it in the mail box at: **Town of Lake Mills, 1111 South Main Street, Lake Mills, WI 53551.**

Please note, a few subscribers to this website's emailing list, actually reside outside of the Town of Lake Mills, so please be sure you are a qualified elector of the Town of Lake Mills before making your ballot request. If you are unsure where you should make requests or vote, [click here](#), and the Government Accountabilities Website information can help clarify this.

Absentee ballots can be mailed to requestors starting March 12, 2013 for electors who already have a request on file. Others received after **March 12th up to Thursday, March 28, 2013** (Deadline to request absentee ballot by mail) will be mailed once the request has been received.

The Spring Election is just a few days after the Easter Holiday so please review if you will need an absentee ballot or not and make the request as soon as possible.

Absentee ballots requests using the mail system is the preferred method but in-person absentee voting can be arranged with the town clerk by appointment from Monday, March 18, 2013 through Friday, March 29, 2013 (deadline is 5:00pm) at the clerk's home office. PLEASE call ahead to make an appointment.

Long lines are not expected for the Spring Election like we experienced for the Nov. Presidential but parking is always an issue. Parking will be allowed in the parking lot of the former "J J's Bar" (please walk around the front of the old building rather than cutting through the back yard area of J J's) and street parking is available on South Main Street.

The polling location at the Town Hall is open from 7am-8pm on election day!
