**VISITATION AND MEMORIAL SERVICES HONORING FALLEN LAKE MILLS FIRE
DEPARTMENT CAPTAIN CHRISTOPHER TRUMAN**

Lake Mills, WI

On the evening of December 31, 2018, LMFD Captain Christopher Truman was struck and killed by a motorist on the Beltline in Monona, Wisconsin.

Captain Truman had witnessed a single car accident and, in accordance with his character and training, stopped to render assistance to occupants of the vehicle. In the process of this selfless act, Captain Truman's life was cut short. During his life, Captain Truman had a profound effect on his friends and family, the Lake Mills Fire Department, and the Lake Mills community. Captain Truman's death has affected a much broader area on a much greater scale. Captain Truman died a hero, deserving celebration and remembrance.

A public visitation is being held to honor Captain Truman on Saturday, January 5, 2019, from 3pm - 7pm at the Lake Mills High School with an Emergency Service Member Fly-By Salute to occur starting at 5pm.

On Sunday, January 6, 2019, a second visitation will be held

from 2pm - 3pm at the Lake Mills High School with a memorial service to immediately follow from 3pm - 4pm.

A map of the area around the Lake Mills High School which illustrates the available parking for service members, family, media and the public has been included with this release. Overflow parking and shuttle service will be available to attendees of both visitation and memorial services on both Saturday, January 5 and Sunday, January 6. Additionally, the map provides for an area dedicated to media staging on the Lake Mills High School site.
