

Safe Boating Reminders

1. Have on board properly-sized PFD for each person
2. US Coast Guard approved throwable PFD required on watercraft 16' or longer.
3. Maintain a working fire extinguisher on all enclosed boats.
4. Display weight limit tags and operate within those limits.
5. Slow-No-Wake after sunset.
6. Slow-No-Wake within 100' of shore.
7. Skiing, Aqua Planing or similar activities allowed from 10 AM to 7 PM.

 (Limited Parking available. Check before docking)

Southwest: **Elm Point Road**

West - **Ferry Drive**, off Shorewood Hills Road
 (Small turnaround - limited parking)

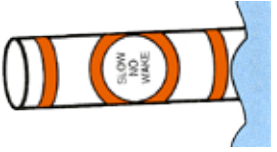

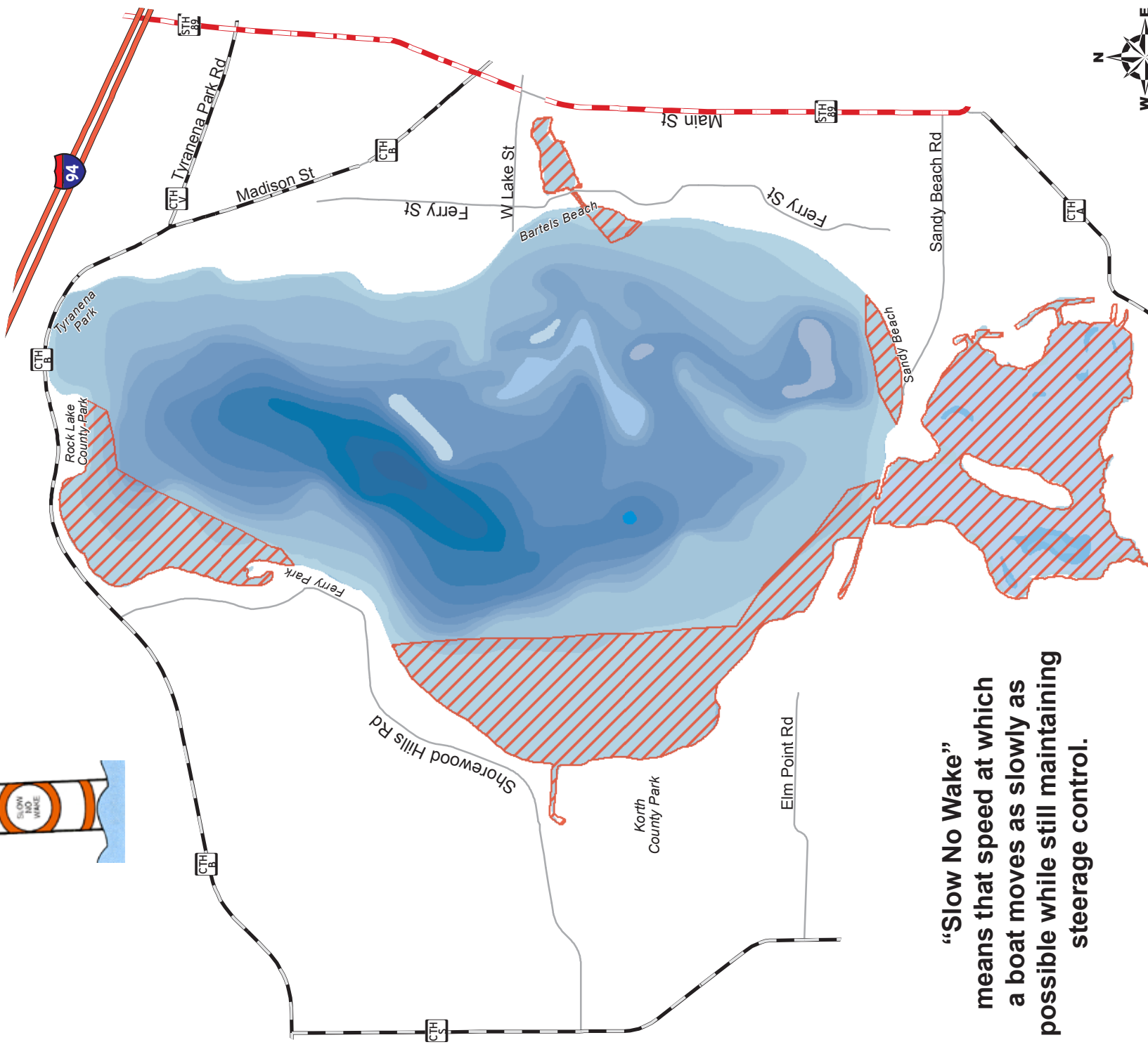

Slow No Wake Areas



“Slow No Wake” means that speed at which a boat moves as slowly as possible while still maintaining steerage control.
